- A letter of intent in which you describe your professional goals/objectives and your reasons for wanting to participate in the Tamarind Professional Training Program.
- A complete personal résumé (can include an artist résumé).
- Transcripts from up to three art schools, colleges, and/or universities you have attended most recently. If your transcripts cannot be included in your packet, please arrange to have them sent directly to Tamarind. Emailed transcripts should be sent to tamarineducation@unm.edu.
- 10 – 20 digital images of either your own artwork, or lithographs you have printed for another artist. Include slides that demonstrate the range of your experience in lithography. Images should be in Powerpoint, PDF, or JPG format (200dpi and 2000px max on the longest edge), with caption information on each slide including the following details: Artist, Title, Year, Paper/Image size, Edition size. Indicate if it was printed from plate(s) or stone(s) and whether it was printed on an offset or direct press. You may send your images on a thumb-drive, through a link to a cloud service (OneDrive, Dropbox, etc.), or upload them through our website.
- A list of your three professional references (submitted with your application).
- Three letters of reference from professionals (sent separately from your application) who are familiar with your work. Letters should be sent from each reference directly to Tamarind with the subject line “(YOUR NAME) PTP REFERENCE 2022.” See Submission Methods below for options your referee can use to submit their letter.
